### SCRIPTURE: Matthew 5:38-42

**SERMON SUMMARY:** This week we continue to study our God, learning His attributes in order to fall in love with Him more! As we discuss the fact that GOD IS JUST, we will look at Matthew 5:38-42. As we open up God's Word, think about these questions:

- How would you define JUST/what does it mean to call someone JUST?
- Do you think God is JUST? What experiences have you had that lead you to this answer?
- What is the tie between God being JUST and FAITH?
- What scripture passages would you add to the discussion of God being JUST?

As action points to this discussion, here are some suggestions:

- Do a word search (via internet or Bible Study book, etc.) on the word JUST in Scripture. What passages stick out to you? What passages surprise you? Which ones confuse you?
- Take notice this week of phrases like "the right thing to do" or "ethical" or even "moral." Think through the situation in which they are being used. Think through how the decision of "the right thing" is made. What is the foundation for that decision? Who decided "the right thing" and why?
- Work towards an understanding that God is ALWAYS JUST. What does that do for your faith? Can you accept that He is ALWAYS JUST? Can you trust Him, even if you cannot understand Him?
