**SERMON TOPIC**: Foundations, Part 2

SERMON SUMMARY: Last week we began to look at the Foundations of the Christian Faith. To guide our conversations, we'll be working our way through the Apostles' Creed. Today we will focus on the statement..."[I believe] in Jesus Christ, His only begotten Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of the virgin Mary..."

In the Apostle's Creed, each word has been carefully chosen and carries importance; knowing this, we will ask several questions:

First, why is it important to say "Jesus," and why is it important to say "Christ?" Why do we need to say "begotten?" Why "our Lord?" Why "conceived by the Holy Spirit?" And finally, why is it important to say "born of the virgin Mary?"

The hope is that by looking at these six intentional words or phrases, we will know Jesus more. As we know Him more we will then love Him more. And as we love Him more, we will desire to serve Him more! It begins by knowing who Jesus is and why it is we confess our belief in Him through the Apostle's Creed. **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:**
