- $\Rightarrow$  Take one step to find what you can do for your church. Serve your church as though you were serving Christ Himself.
- ⇒ Prayerfully ask the Holy Spirit to reveal any situations where communion has been stretched too thin. Pray about what God would have you do to help rebuild that. Follow through in whatever way is revealed to you.
