SCRIPTURE: Mark 10:35-45

SERMON SUMMARY: This week, we will be talking about Mark 10:35-45. In this passage, two of Jesus' disciples ask for seats of power when it comes time for eternal life. In His response Jesus challenges the normal order of things and reminds all of us that we are to have a different way of living.

As we wrestle with this passage, here are some discussion questions for you to consider:

1. It seems the other disciples were upset with James and John for asking to sit at Jesus' right and left. Why would they be upset, do you think? Get curious about the thought patterns of not only James and John, but also of the rest of the disciples. Put yourself in the shoes of several different characters in the story and see if you can rationalize why James and John would ask that, why the disciples would be upset, and why Jesus would answer the way He did.

2. Are power and prestige the only things Jesus is talking about here? Could He be talking about more than just where we sit in eternal life? What else could He be referring to? What is the big picture that He is trying to show you and us?

3. How can you wrestle with flipping the order of things around? How can you look at your life from the outside and ask: "Is this the correct order of things, according to Jesus?"

<u>Stewardship Team Update</u>

Thank you for your generous giving for the ministries of Living Water Community Church during the third quarter of our fiscal year (July 2018 – September 2018). Here are a few highlights based off the September 30, 2018 financial statements: **Revenue & Disbursements Update** – For the first quarter of this fiscal year (July

- 2018 September 2018) we currently have a deficit of (-**\$11,592.52**). Total Revenue / Income = \$90,248.92
 - Total Disbursements / Expenses = \$101,841.44
 - Net Increase / (Decrease) = (-\$11,592.52)

<u>LW Cash-Flow Update</u> – The Living Water accounts at Northwestern Bank had a balance of \$70,449.61 on September 30, 2018.

It costs LWCC approximately **\$1,375** to operate on a daily basis. With our cash balances, we have about **51 days** of operating money. The Stewardship Team has a goal of getting up to greater than 75 days of operating cash.

Building Debt Update – We currently have one loan to the SH Christian School Foundation for **\$100,000**. Our debt to equity (the amount of debt based on the market value of our two campuses) is very strong. We are very healthy from a debt perspective.

GRACE Update - Our GRACE/Fair Share obligation for the new school year (2018-19) is \$100,745.00 (53 Students).

As of September 30, 2018 - we have paid the schools **\$7,900.00 or 8%.** The remaining balance is **\$92,845.00 or 92%** as of September 30, 2018.
