SCRIPTURE: Luke 22:39-53

SERMON SUMMARY: Lent is a beautiful time of preparing our hearts for Easter, for the death and resurrection of the Son of God. As a sermon series we are walking through the days of Jesus' last week on earth (often called "passion week") taking one day of the week each Sunday.

Tension. This week's focus is about the tension that existed on this final day before Jesus' crucifixion and death. There are several things from Luke 22:39-53 that seem to be at odds with each other and so we will focus on Jesus' prayer and His arrest, two things that already don't look like they should go together! Pay close attention to some of these points of tension:

- Jesus prayer to have cup taken/"Your will be done"
- sleeping disciples/ "pray that you will not fall"
- betraying the Son of Man/with a kiss
- rebellion and sword/healing a guard's ear
- darkness reigns/God's sovereignty

What does all of this tension mean?

What does it have to do with the Christian faith?

What does it have to do with your life today?

It seems that we may all have the same battle raging within that the Apostle Paul references when he says, "What I want to do I do not do, but what I hate, I do" in Romans 7. Admitting this battle may be a first step in going deeper with Christ. Take some time and consider these action steps:

- Be honest with yourself. Be honest with Christ in prayer. Be honest with a trusted brother or sister in Christ: do you see a battle raging within your soul? How and when does it become clear that this battle is taking place?
- Read through Romans 7 and see if Paul simply admits that struggling with sin and temptation is a problem or if he gives a solution to the tension that exists within Him.
- Watch the movie, "Passion of the Christ." The Youth Group will be watching it on Wednesday, April 17, at 7 pm at the OC Campus. It can be a helpful way to understand what Christ went through. If you haven't seen it before, be aware that some of the scenes are graphic and intense; be wise in choosing if this is something you and/or your children are able to see.

Stewardship Team Update

Thank you for your generous giving for the ministries of Living Water Community Church during the past eight months of our fiscal year (July 2018 – March 2019). As a church, we are passionate about helping Christian's be managers of all of God's gifts. Below are a few highlights based off the March 31, 2019 financial statements. The Stewardship Team

Revenue & Disbursements Update – For the first nine months of this fiscal year (July 2018 – March 2019) we currently have a shortfall of (-\$32,514.72).

- · Total Revenue / Income = \$321,702.68
- · Total Disbursements / Expenses = \$354,217.40
- · Net Increase / (Decrease) = (-\$32,514.72)

<u>LW Cash-Flow Update</u> – The Living Water accounts at Northwestern Bank had a balance of \$46,411.93 on March 31, 2019.

- · It costs LWCC approximately \$1,310 to operate on a daily basis.
- · With our cash balances, we have about 35 days of operating money.
- · The Stewardship Team has a goal of getting up to greater than 75 days of operating cash.

<u>Building Debt Update</u> – We currently have one loan to the Sheldon Christian School Foundation for \$100,000. Our debt to equity (the amount of debt based on the market value of our two campuses) is very strong. We are very healthy from a debt perspective.

<u>GRACE Update</u> - Our GRACE/Fair Share obligation for this school year (2018-19) is \$104.545.00 (55 Students).

- · As of March 31, 2019 we have paid the schools \$61,911.04 or 59%.
- The remaining balance is \$42,633.96 or 41% as of April 1, 2019.
