#### Welcome to Living Water Community Church on Easter Sunday! Today we celebrate our risen Savior!

**TEACHER**: Pastor Garry Nyenhuis

SCRIPTURE: John 20:1-18

**SERMON SUMMARY**: To remind us of our reason to celebrate, we will look at John 20:1-18 as the empty tomb is discovered and Jesus appears to Mary Magdalene.

Reading through this passage, think through some of these things:

- What does the context (what has happened before and what is happening during) mean for this passage? Why is it important to know the "backstory"?
- What are the different reactions on Easter Sunday (Mary's, John's, Peter's)? What do these reactions show us?
- Mary stays, other disciples go; what is the relevance of their actions?
- In the "second half," Mary is asked a basic question, "Why are you crying?" What is this question setting up?
- Why is Jesus speaking Mary's name significant?
- What is the basis of Mary's testimony?

This Easter account is a living and active word. In it, we are directed to the Word, Jesus Christ. How is it moving you this morning? Here are some possible ways to allow the word to work through you as you meet the Word:

- Read the story of Jesus' resurrection every day this week, taking time to reflect on the specific information of each gospel account. You will find the story in the following passages:
- $\Rightarrow$  Matthew 28:1-10
- $\Rightarrow$  Mark 16:1-20
- $\Rightarrow$  Luke 24:1-12
- $\Rightarrow$  John 20:1-18
- What basic question is Jesus presenting you with this morning? Could it be "why are you crying?" Answer Him, through prayer, journaling, speaking out loud to Him or speaking with a trusted brother or sister in Christ.
- Are you mistaking Christ for something or someone else?
- What is the basis of your testimony? Like Mary, are you able to clearly speak "I have seen the Lord!"? If so, are you speaking it? If not, why not? Is it time to share your "I have seen the Lord" story?
