WELCOME! We're glad you're here and have decided to join us today!

This week we begin looking at the book of Acts! This New Testament book has been called a textbook for discipleship and as Living Water seeks to make disciples who make disciples, I really believe we have a lot to learn from Acts.

TEACHER: Pastor Garry Nyenhuis

SUMMARY: For week 1, we will focus on the introduction to the letter, the command of Jesus for the disciples to wait, and His ascension into heaven.

As we discuss, think about some of these things:

- 1. What assumptions does the author make about who is reading this account?
- 2. What is the importance of recalling what Jesus has been doing since His resurrection?
- 3. What are Jesus' commands before He returns to heaven?
- 4. How does the questions of the disciples show a lack of understanding on their part?
- 5. How does Jesus' redirection help them and help us?

As action steps, try some of these things:

- 1. Study the book of Acts with your friends, family, or small group. Try the Right Now Media study suggested in a previous email. Try walking through the book chapter by chapter with someone. Use a study Bible to read some of the footnotes and historical context of the book. Try the YouVersion app to read through with the pastor and with other brothers and sisters!
- 2. Journal your questions and your thoughts about the book as you read through! Write down the statements or words that seem to stick out to you. Share these with Pastor Garry or with another believer-not necessarily to get "answers" but mainly to wrestle with the words of Scripture and to see what God is pointing out to you.
- 3. Discuss this with a group, spouse, family, friend: Why is it so popular to want to "go back" to the early church? Why did it "work?" What are the dangers in "going back?" What would be the good in "going back?"
