SCRIPTURE: Ruth - Chapters 3 & 4

SUMMARY:

This week we wrap up our look at the book of Ruth by looking at the last two chapters of the book.

We will move through 6 "scenes," including:

- ⇒ Naomi giving Ruth advice
- ⇒ Ruth and Boaz on threshing floor
- ⇒ Ruth goes back to Naomi
- \Rightarrow Boaz at town gate
- ⇒ Boaz and Ruth marry
- ⇒ Boaz's lineage

Thinking through each of these, get curious about some of these things:

- The importance of a mentor.
- What does it look like to step out in faith? Why does the "how" matter?
- What is the importance of patience? Again, why does the "how" matter?
- What does redemption mean?
- Notice the bigger story at play.

Maybe the Holy Spirit is looking to work through this passage in your life in one of these ways:

- Get a mentor. Be a mentor.
- Stay true to the righteousness that God has called you to AND take a step out in faith; write it down and follow through on it.
- Practice patience. Note in a journal how you exhibited patience; or note how you didn't, in order to improve next time! What are your guidelines? What can you not edit? What can you not stray from?
- Listen to a redemption story. Tell your redemption story. Be inspired by the fact that God is in the business of fixing.
- Again, make a life map! See the bigger story that you are a part of.
