SCRIPTURE: Luke11:2-4

This week we look at the statement "forgive us our debts as we forgive our debtors" from the Lord's Prayer. Here are some guidelines to help us with this passage:

1. Forgiveness is tough.
2. We each need it.
3. Part of the process of forgiveness is being forgiven.
4. Knowing I am forgiven allows me to forgive.
5. Forgiveness is tough.

"Grace" is an important word for our service today. Grace is what Christ offers to us through His death on the cross and it's what He asks us to offer to others. In order to offer it to others, we have to experience it first. That is what we will try to help you realize and experience today.

As we do, take time to think about:

1. What do I need to ask God to forgive me of today?
2. What needs to happen for me to know I am truly forgiven?
3. Who am I being called to forgive?

Confess your sins today to your Heavenly Father; confess them to a trusted believer in Christ; write a letter to yourself, using God's words for you from Scripture; write a letter to someone you need to forgive.
